Freedom of Information Request A47 Acle Straight – accidents involving animals

I am writing to confirm that we have now completed our search for the information which you requested on 14 May.

You asked for details of the number of accidents reported on the A47 Acle Straight/Acle New Road between Great Yarmouth and Acle which have involved animals since 2000. In particular, we would like to know the number of accidents, the type of animal(s) involved and details of the owner of these animals, if available.

We only hold information from 2007 onwards. We do not hold information about the type of animal involved or the owner details, where applicable, as accidents on the A47 are police led. Our primary role in such incidents on the A47 will be to ensure the road is safe to re-open once the incident has been cleared.
