## **JUDGMENT**

## The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The respondent's application for costs under Rule 76 (1)(a) of the Employment Tribunal (Constitution & Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 succeeds.
- 2. The Tribunal considers that the claimant has acted vexatious, abusively, disruptively and otherwise unreasonably in bringing of the proceedings and in the way that proceedings have been conducted.
- 3. The claimant is ordered to pay to the respondent the specified sum of £20,000 in respect of the respondent's costs.
