## PROVISION OF REQUESTED INFORMATION

Thank you for your request for information on Serbian Dogs entering the UK which we received on 26 June 2018. Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOI).

The information you requested and our response is detailed below:

"further to my request for information on Serbian dogs entering the UK, I would request the number of dogs entering the UK on Traces with their point of origin as Bosnia or Macedonia and entering the EU via a Croatian BIP. I would be grateful if you could provide the yearly figures from 2014-2018.

Please do not include dogs which have incorrectly been added to Romanian traces",

The number of dogs from Bosnia which entered the EU through a BIP in Croatia with a destination of the UK is as follows:

2016 - 20 2017 - 53 2018 (to 28<sup>th</sup> June) - 17

There were no records of dogs imported from Macedonia 2014 – 2015 to the UK through a BIP in Croatia during this period.

This data was extracted from TRACES using the Data Warehouse facility. This information is a true reflection of the information that we have access to. We can't guarantee the accuracy of this data, as we can only rely on the information that has been input into TRACES by a third party.
