Keep your passport on you at all times

Random ID checks are common in Japan. You may need to present your passport to the police. Make sure to keep it on you. Photocopies are not an option.



It is hot here!

You may experience high temperatures and humid weather, especially in the South. Keep hydrated and beware of heat strokes.



Respect the law

Avoid any involvement with drugs or any illegal activities. Fines are heavy and sentences are long, it is not worth the risk.



Emergency?

Call 110 for the police or 119 for an ambulance (request a *kyukyusha*) or fire service (*kaji*). Keep note of the British Embassy details in case you need our support.
