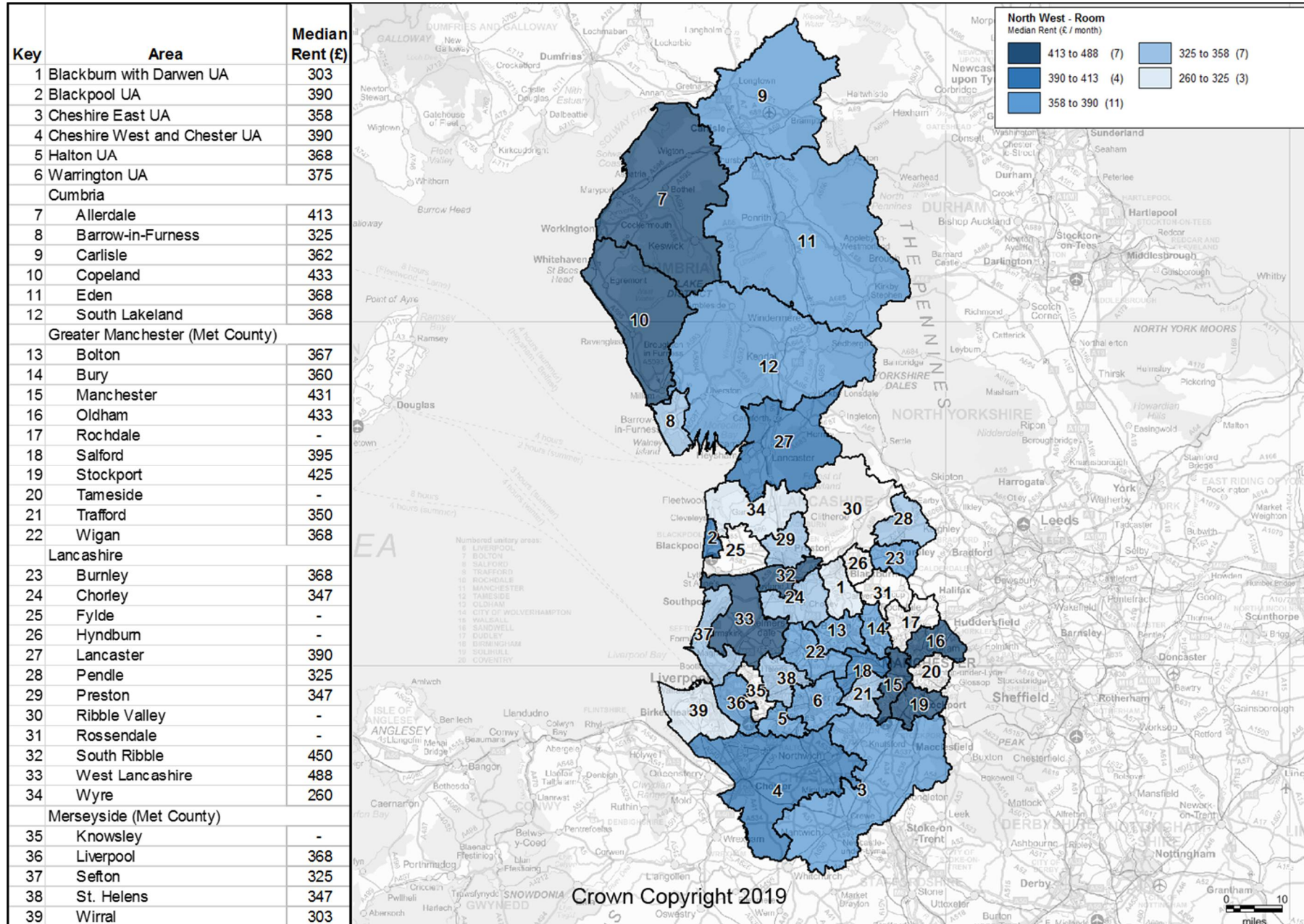


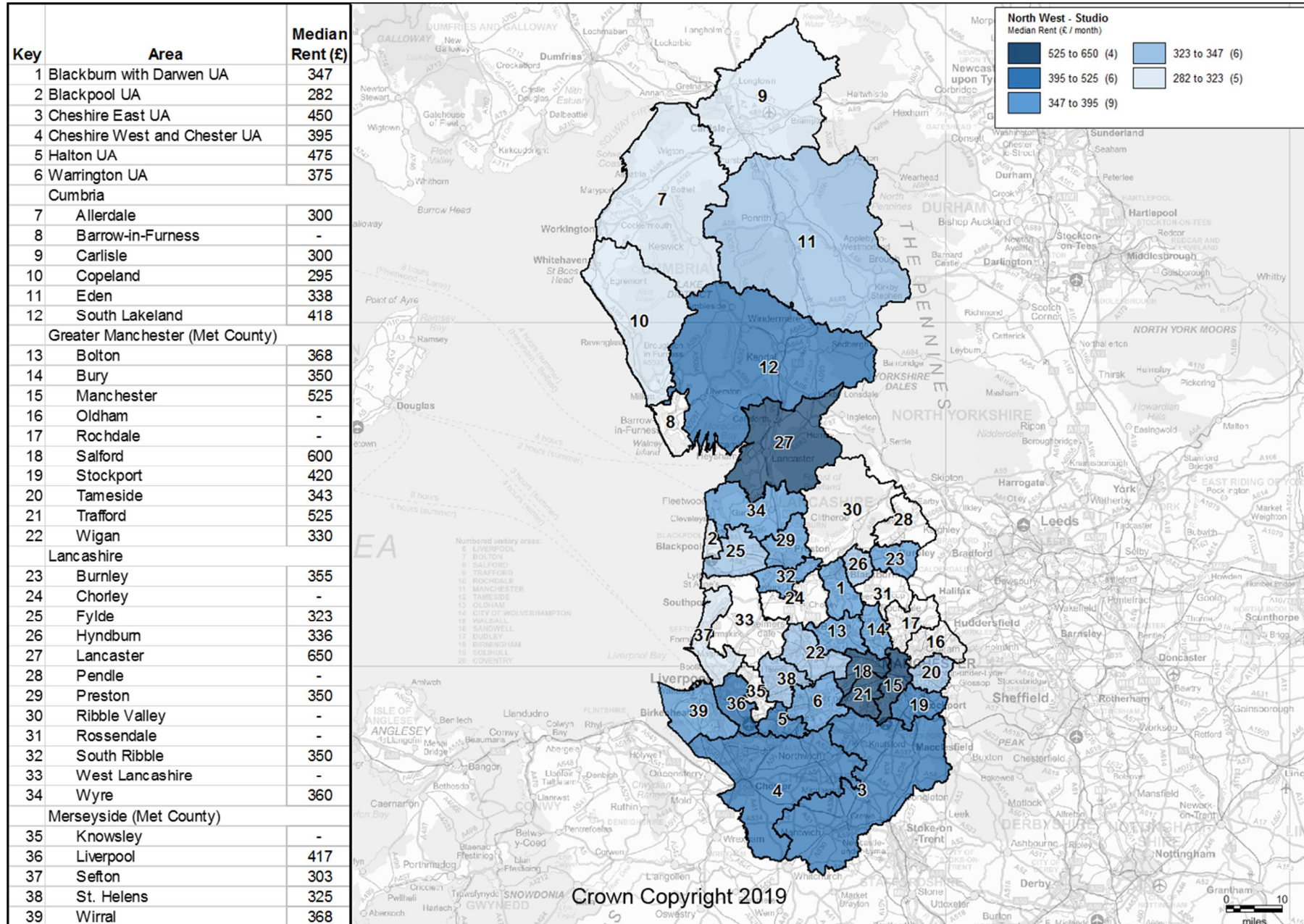
# Private Rental Market Statistics, 'Room' monthly rents recorded between 1 April 2018 and 31 March 2019 for the North West

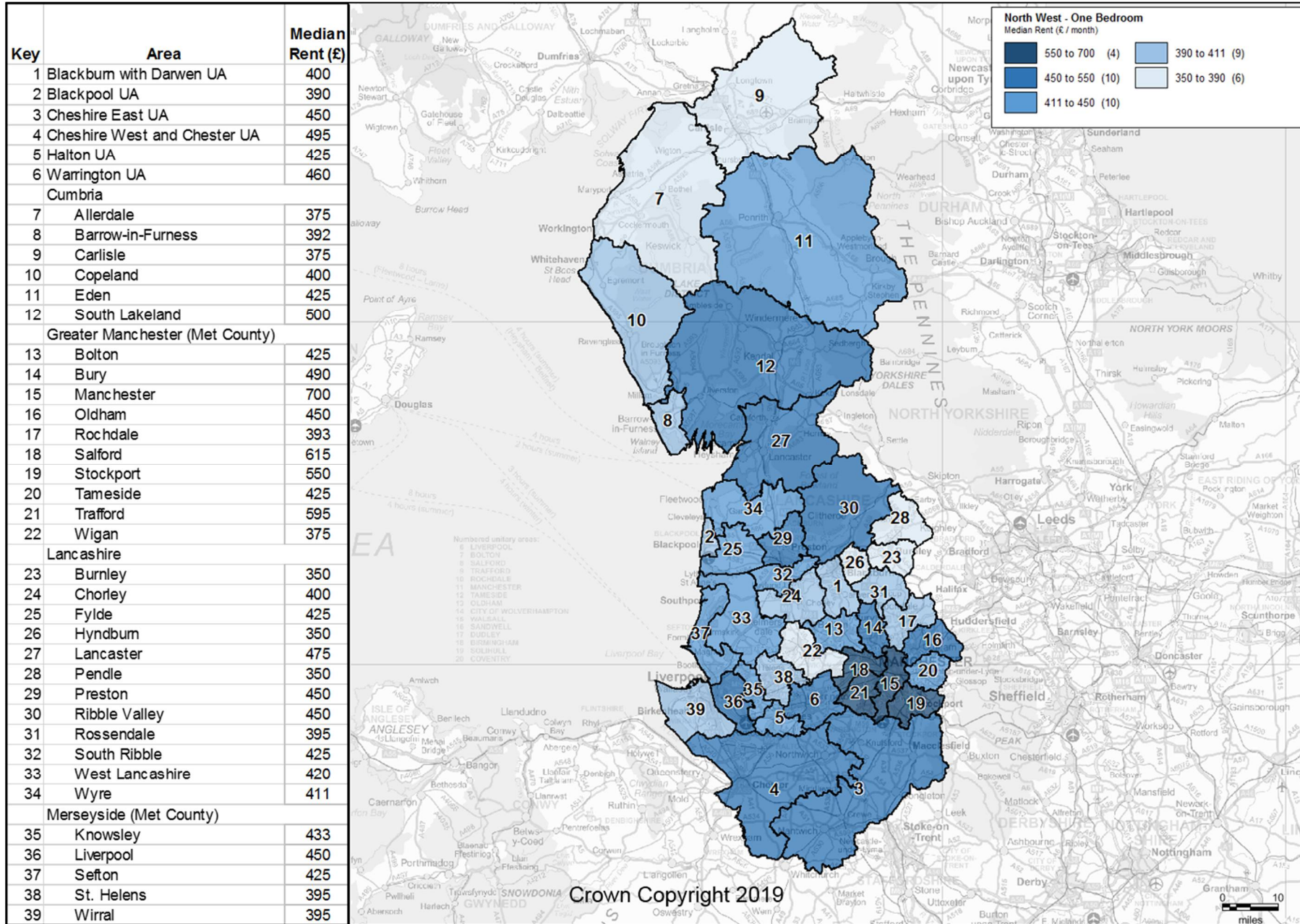
# Private Rental Market Statistics, 'Studio' monthly rents recorded between 1 April 2018 and 31 March 2019 for the North West

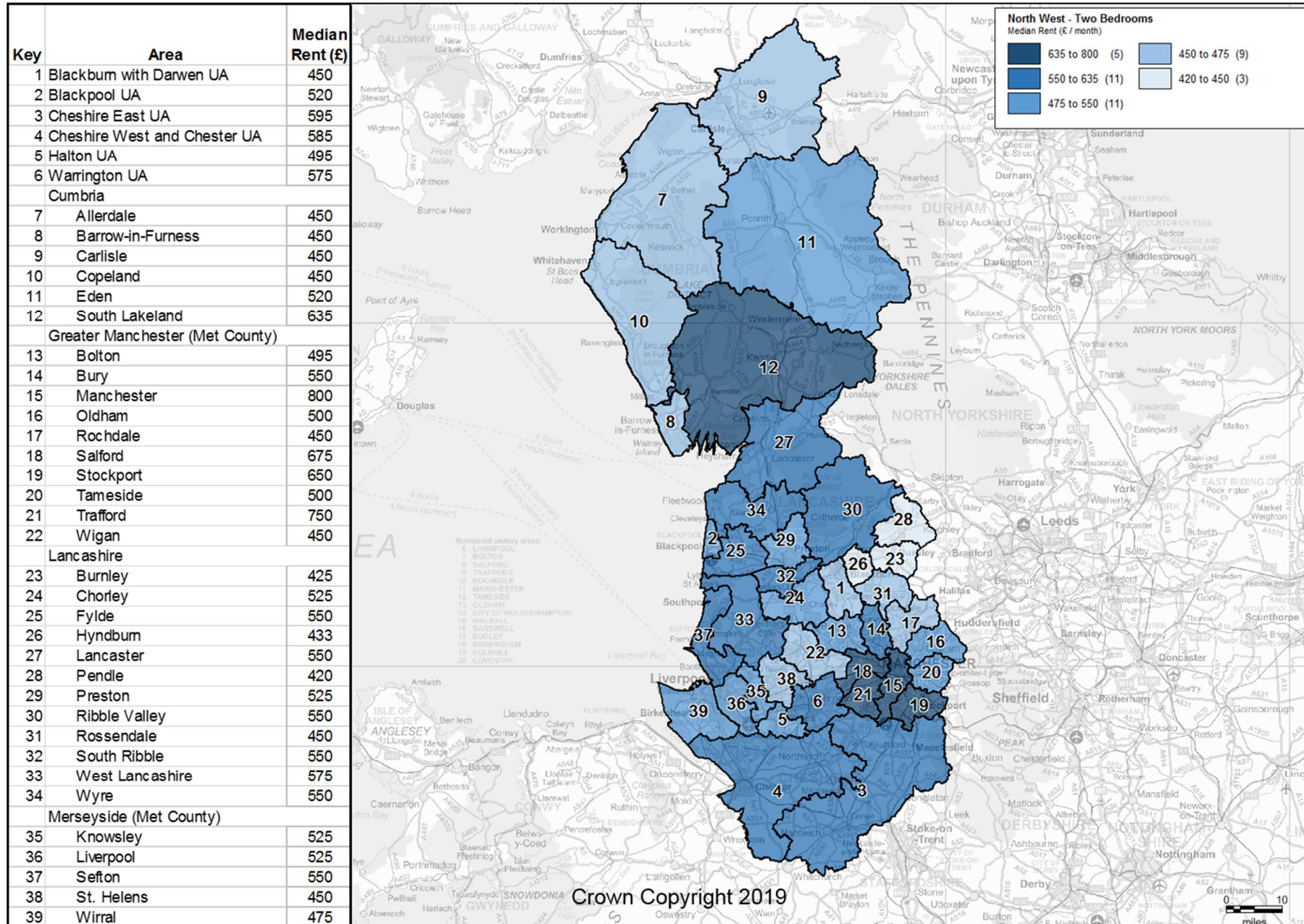
## Private Rental Market Statistics, 'One Bedroom' monthly rents recorded between 1 April 2018 and 31 March 2019 for the North West

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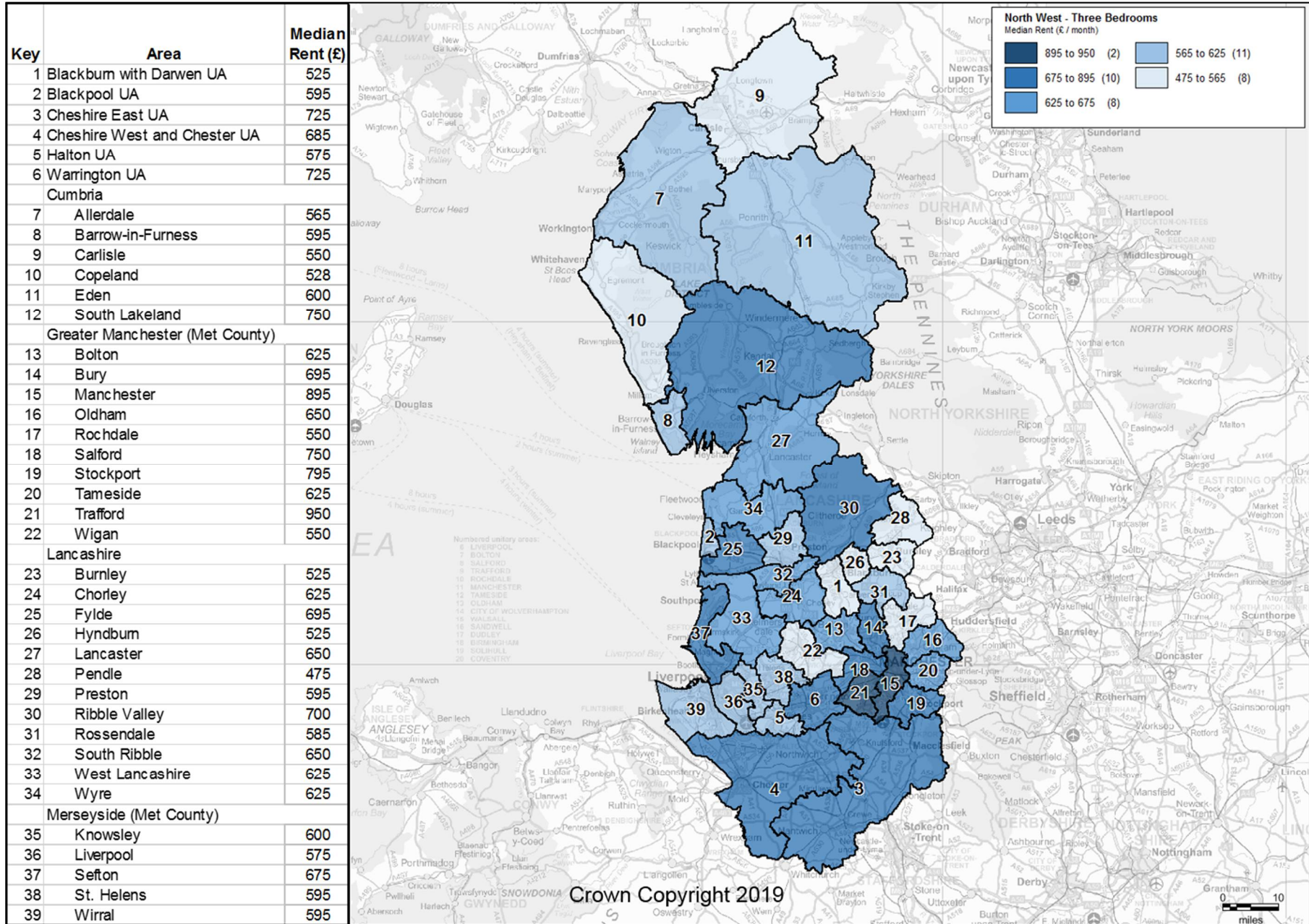

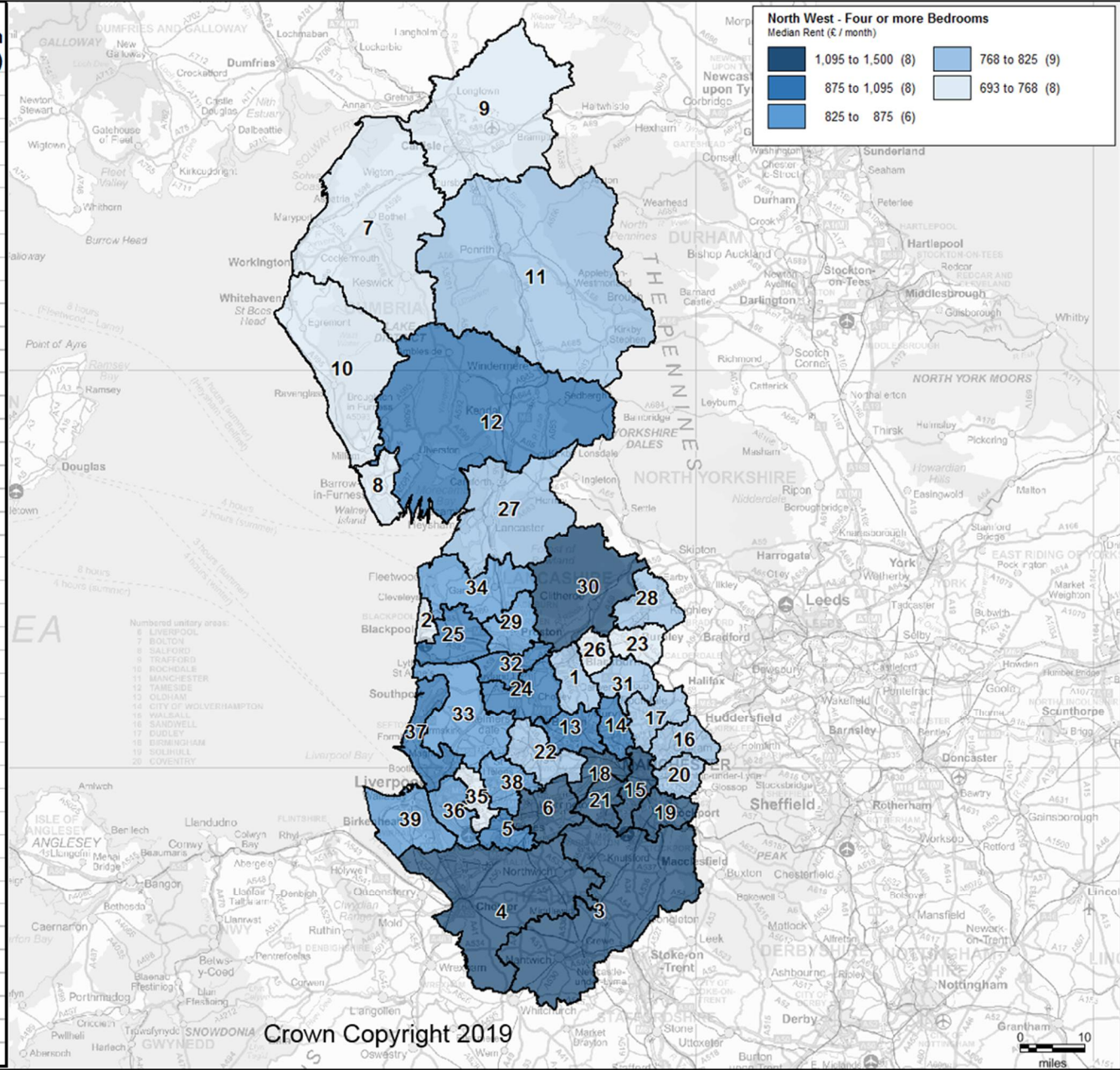

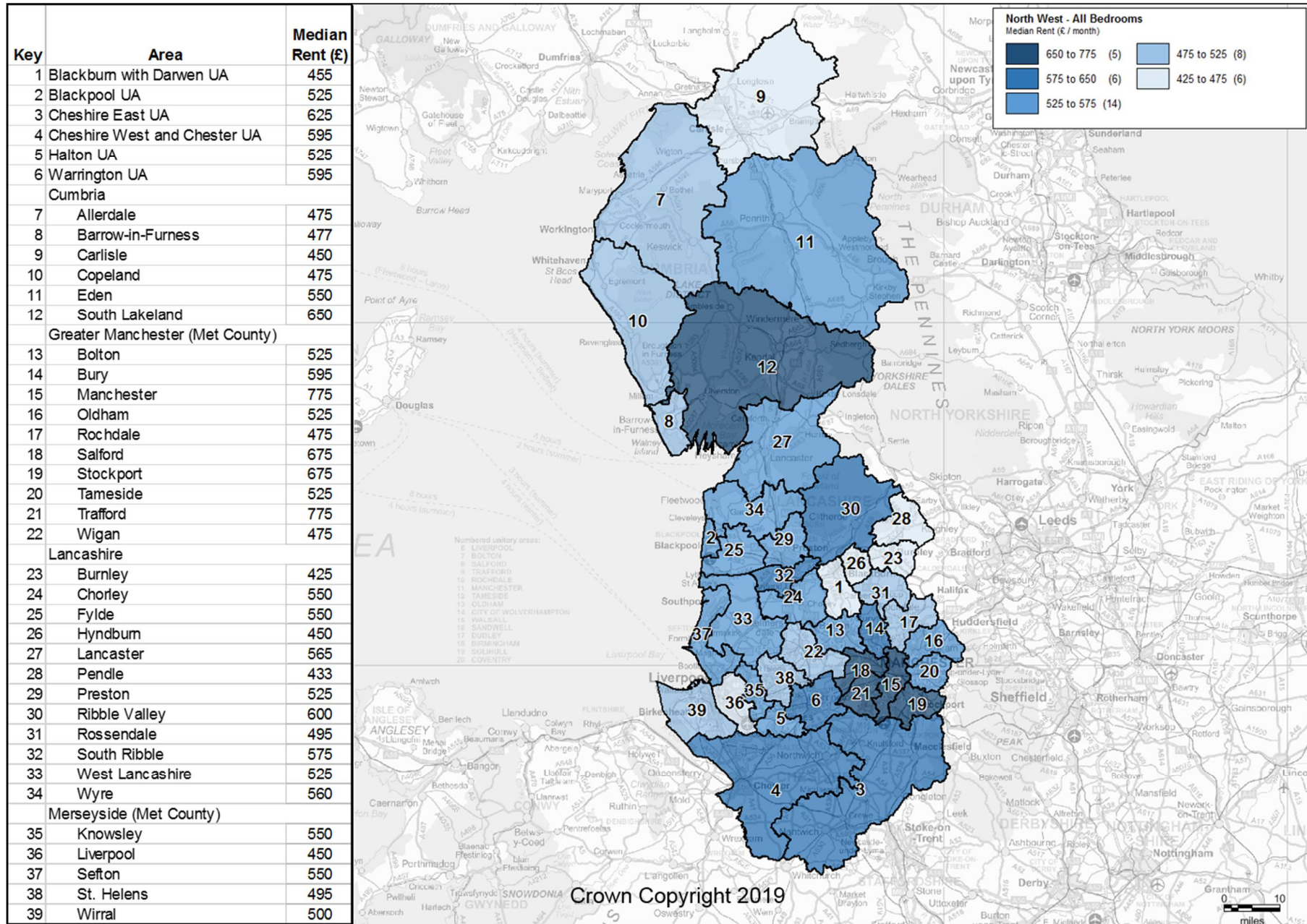
