Thank you for your email of 9 November 2018 requesting the following information:

"I would like to know the cost of road repairs for the last five years to the Eastern and Western Sovereign Base Areas and the cost of repairs carried out to Snake Road, Dhekelia"

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held.
