Thank you for your email of 15 November 2018 requesting the following information:

"Are cleaning waivers still offered on SFA properties that have 'march-ins' based on substandard conditions/cleanliness during the hand-over process with the Amey Accommodation Officers?"

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and I can confirm that the information in scope of your request is held.

The information you have requested can be found below.

Cleaning waivers are not offered in Service Family Accommodation (SFA). Cleaning is an occupant requirement under the SFA Move Out procedures. The occupant can clean the property themselves or agree and pre-pay some or all the charges to the contractor to clean on their behalf. Cleaning charges are based on the agreed contract schedule of rates.

Please note that the Information Commissioner will not normally investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
