JUDGMENT

- 1 The claimant's complaint of unfair dismissal is dismissed: it was not presented within the relevant time limits and it was reasonably practicable for the complaint to have been presented in time.
- The claimant's complaint that his dismissal and maintenance of dismissal on appeal were acts of discrimination arising in consequence of disability do not succeed and are dismissed.
- The claimant's first, third, fourth, fifth and sixth complaints of harassment or direct disability discrimination do not succeed and are dismissed.
- The claimant's second complaint (harassment or direct disability discrimination concerning the provision of a van for his work) was presented outside the applicable time limits and the Tribunal does not consider it just and equitable to extend time to decide this complaint; it is dismissed for this reason.
