

Public Law Applications to Orders

Data Visualisation Tool

Introduction

This PLATO tool is an update on the original version published in March 2018. The original was the first output of the Children in Family Justice Data Share (a matched dataset between family court data, Cafcass data and the Department for Education's National Pupil Database) and this enhanced version joins the original and the 'Who Are The Children?' (WATCh) tools. It builds on the existing overview of public law application and order patterns over time and across geographical areas, to add contextual information such as levels of deprivation, and presenting child population against public law demand, so each area can interpret their data against national trends
