Thank you for your email of 21 May 2019 requesting the following information:

"Could you please inform me on how many incursions have taken place on the Pilgrims Cross to Bull Hill route when firing was not taking place between 1/1/18 and 31/12/18 including the date and time and whether the incursion was reported by a member of public or MOD personnel."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and I can confirm that all of the information in scope of your request is held. The information you have requested can be found in the table below.
