Thank you for your email of 23 November 2018 requesting the following information:

"Can you please provide the following information with regards to the use of public funds allocated for the upkeep of the RAF Benson estate.

- Total amount allocated for the last 5 years, with amounts clearly stated for each financial year.
- Total amount spent for the last 5 years, with amounts clearly stated for each financial year.
- A breakdown for each year on how the budget was divided among the different areas of RAF Benson (e.g Technical site, JR barrack blocks, SNCO Mess, Leisure facilities).
- Per year breakdown of amounts spent on each area (e.g Technical site, JR barrack blocks, SNCO Mess, Leisure facilities).
- Where money has not been spent, please provide an explanation for why money was not re-allocated to a different area or spent on general maintenance."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and I can confirm that some information in scope of your request is held and therefore I can answer as follows:
