Thank you for your email of 22 January 2019 requesting the following information:

"I wish to see the document stated below IEMP 2016/17.

A paragraph was also used that did not refer to a document. The paragraph is below and I wish to know what document that paragraph came from –

Policy. *Specific challenges of policy should be submitted through the chain of command to the appropriate single Service Housing Colonel, in accordance with the process detailed in Chapter 1, Para 0104.*

I also would like to make a request and would like to know how many non – Warrant Officers are housed in [REDACTED] Married Quarters at RAF Halton."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and I can confirm that some information in scope of your request is held.

The paragraph '**Policy.
