"Can you please advise me of live firing exercises at Cape Wrath-from the beginning to end of August 2019"

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held.

The information you have requested can be found below:

At present, there are no live firing exercises due to take place at Cape Wrath from 1 – 31 August 2019. However, if a timely request is submitted, this situation may change.
