Goods Vehicles (Licensing of Operators) Act 1995 ("the Act")

<u>Decisions made in respect of the restricted operator's licence held by Oakridge</u> <u>Direct Ltd OG0091877</u>

- 1. Adverse findings are made under sections 26(1)(ca); 26(1)(f); and, 26(1)(c)(i) and (ii) of the Act.
- 2. I do not make any adverse finding under section 26(1)(h) of the Act and record that the operator remains fit to hold an operator's licence and additionally has sufficient financial resources.
- 3. Authorisation is curtailed from 20 vehicles to 15 vehicles.

Decisions made in respect of transport manager Malcolm Streeter

4. Malcolm Streeter has lost his repute as a transport manager. He is disqualified from holding or applying for any transport manager position within the EU until he qualifies afresh, i.e. he will need to pass transport manager examinations.
