- I, the undersigned official veterinarian, hereby certify, that the animals described above meet the following requirements:
- (1) (a) (b) The animals were born and have been reared since birth in Union territory.
 - (1) (a) (b) The animals were imported from a third country complying with the entry health conditions laid down in Commission Regulation (EC) No 2002/20, at least 30 days prior to leaving the third country.
 - (1) (a) (b) The animals have been inspected today (within 24 hours prior to loading) and show no clinical signs of disease.
 - (1) (a) (b) (i) we use animals which are to be transported under a scheme to eradicate a zoonotic or infectious disease, for the last 42 days in the case of bovine, for the last 30 days in the case of other, same farm holdings which have been free from any official prohibition on health grounds, for the last 42 days in the case of bovine, for the last 30 days in the case of other, for the last 15 days in the case of swine, and, have not been in contact with animals from holdings which did not comply with these conditions;
 - (1) (a) (b) (ii) do not come from a holding not have been in contact with animals from a holding in a protection zone which has been set up under Union legislation and which animals are prohibited to leave;
 - (1) (a) (b) (iii) are not the subject of official health measures pursuant to Union legislation or have not recently been vaccinated against foot-and-mouth disease;
 - (1) (a) (b) (iv) Based on the written declaration made by the keeper or an examination of the holding register and movement documents kept in accordance with Council Regulation (EC) No 21/2004, in particular in Sections B and C of the Annex to that Regulation;
 - (1) (a) (b) (v) the animals have remained on a single holding of origin for a period of at least the last 21 days, or on the holding of origin since birth where the animals are less than 21 days old, and no Member State animal imported from a third country has been introduced into the holding of origin during the last 30 days, unless those animals were introduced in accordance with Article 4a(2) of Council Directive 609/EEC, and
 - (1) (a) (b) (vi) have remained on a single holding of origin into which no animals of the same or opposite species have been introduced, unless those animals were introduced in accordance with Article 4a(2) of Council Directive 609/EEC, during the last 21 days;
 - (1) (a) (b) (vii) are to be assigned directly from a single holding to the slaughterhouse destination.
 - (1) (a) (b) (viii) The animals were transported using means of transport and containment which had, before hand, been cleaned and disinfected using an officially approved disinfectant, and in such a way as to provide effective protection of the animals' health status.
 - (1) (a) (b) (ix) All of the official documentation accompanying the animals, the transport permit and the health certificate to be used for the journey to the destination.
 - (1) (a) (b) (x) At the time of inspection the animals covered by this health certificate were fit to be transported on the intended journey in accordance with the provisions of Council Regulation (EC) No 1009/2004.
 - (1) (a) (b) (xi) This certificate is valid for 10 days from the date of inspection on the holding of origin, or in the approved assembly centre or approved dealer's premises in the Member State of origin.
 - (1) (a) (b) (xii) Issued in accordance with Article 9(2) of Council Directive 609/EEC or (insert date) of [redacted].
