JUDGMENT

1. The complaint by the Claimant that he was subjected to one or more detriments in contravention of section 47B of the Employment Rights Act 1996 (on the ground that he made one or more protected disclosures) fails, and his claim in that respect is dismissed.
2. Under Rule 76 of the Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure the Respondent is ordered to pay the sum of £1,125 to the Claimant for costs (such costs arising from the Claimant's photocopying expenses).
3. The Claimant's claim for unauthorised deduction of wages shall be listed for hearing on a date to be notified to the parties.
