Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by:

- Adding to them Bridleway No. 18 in the Parish of Bradwell from Point A (Ordnance Survey Grid Reference "GR") (GR SK 1786 8066) proceeding in a generally south easterly then north easterly direction to Point B (GR SK 1791 8066). Then turning in a generally southerly direction then generally north easterly direction to Point C (GR SK 1800 8068) a distance of 245 metres or thereabouts, as shown on the Order map. The width of the path shall be 3 metres;
- Adding to them Bridleway No. 18 in the Parish of Bradwell from Point F (GR SK 1821 8100) proceeding in a generally south south easterly, then south south westerly then in a south south easterly direction to Point H (GR SK 1824 8083), a distance of 183 metres or thereabouts. as shown on the Order map. The width of the path shall be 3 metres;
- **Downgrading** part of Bridleway No. 18 in the Parish of Bradwell from the aforementioned Point A (GR SK 1786 8066) proceeding in a generally south easterly, then easterly direction to Point D (GR SK 1793 8058). Then in a generally north easterly direction through Point E (GR SK 1796 8061) to the aforementioned Point C (GR SK 1800 8068), a distance of 235 metres or thereabouts, as shown on the Order map. The width of the path shall vary between 2 and 3 metres, and;
- **Deleting** from the Definitive Map and Statement for the area the full width of that part of Bridleway No. 18 in the Parish of Bradwell from the aforementioned Point F (GR SK 1821 8100) proceeding in a generally north north easterly direction to Point G (GR SK 1824 8105), a distance of 62 metres or thereabouts, as shown on the Order map.

As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 11 July 2019]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

This order is made by Derbyshire County Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement in respect of the Parish of Bradwell require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i), (ii) & (iii) of the Act, namely, the discovery by that authority of evidence which when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them shows that the right of way referred to in this order which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates and that the highway referred to in this order and shown on the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description and that there is no public right of way over land shown in the map and statement as a highway of any description, or any other particulars contained in the map and statement require modification.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Derbyshire County Council hereby order that:

- 1. For the purpose of this order the relevant date is 15th September 2010.
- 2. The Definitive Map and Statement for the County Of Derbyshire for the Parish of Bradwell shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map to the order.
