## JUDGMENT

1. The claimant's claim for breach of contract in respect of notice pay succeeds and the respondent is ordered to pay the sum of £532.00 in respect of one week's notice pay.
2. The claimant's claim for unauthorized deductions in respect of nine days unpaid holiday succeeds and the respondent is ordered to pay the sum of £957.60.
3. Pursuant to section 24(2) of the Employment Rights Act 1996 the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £154.61 in compensation for financial loss sustained by the claimant attributable to the unauthorized deductions from wages claim.
4. Pursuant to rules 76(1)(a) &(b) and rule 79 of the Employment Tribunal Rules of Procedure 2013 the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £495 in respect of the claimant's preparation time.
