LOCALISED COUNCIL TAX SUPPORT ADMINISTRATION SUBSIDY GRANT DETERMINATION (2019-20): No31/3730.

The Parliamentary Under Secretary of State for Local Government, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 31 of the Local Government Act 2003, makes the following determination:

Citation

1) This determination may be cited as the Localised Council Tax Support Administration Subsidy Grant (2019-20) [No31/3730].

Purpose of the grant

2) The purpose of the grant is to compensate local authorities for the cost of administering Local Council Tax support (LCTS) in 2019-20.

Determination

- 3) The Parliamentary Under Secretary of State determines as the authorities to which grant is to be paid and the amount of grant to be paid, the authorities and the amounts set out in Annex A.
- 4) Payment of grant will be by a single instalment in May 2019.

Treasury consent

5) Before making this determination in relation to local authorities in England, the Parliamentary Under Secretary of State obtained the consent of the Treasury.
