- "1. How many BME people there are in the BAF?
 Please split this into the Naval Service; British Army and RAF and provide figures from 2013-recent.
- 2. Of the BME serving in the BAF, how many are British and how many are from the Commonwealth countries? Again, please provide figures from 2013-recent.
- 3. Could you provide a breakdown of the religious groups/ethnic origins of those serving in the BAF and again split that further into their nationalities? Again, please provide figures from 2013-recent if possible"
