JUDGMENT

1. The Claimant was unfairly dismissed.
2. The Respondents were in breach of contract.
3. The Claimant is entitled to twelve days accrued holiday pay untaken at the time of his dismissal.
4. The Respondents are ordered to pay compensation to the Claimant consisting of the following:-
 - a. Basic award of £375.00;
 - b. Two weeks' notice pay of £750.00;
 - c. Loss of statutory right of £500.00;
 - d. Twelve days holiday pay accrued but untaken and unpaid, £900.00
5. The Respondents are therefore ordered to pay to the Claimant the total sum of **£2,525.00**
