JUDGMENT

My Judgment is that:-

- 1. The claimant was constructively dismissed.
- 2. That dismissal was unfair.
- 3. The claimant did not contribute to the dismissal.
- 4. It is not appropriate to make any deduction from the compensation by virtue of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 section 207A(3).
- 5. The claimant is awarded a basic award of £1,016.
- 6. The compensatory award is to represent loss of healthcare insurance (£100) and loss of statutory rights (£1,000). Accordingly the total compensatory award is £1,100.
- 7. The sums referred to above are to be paid by the respondent to the claimant forthwith.

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8. The Recoupment Regulations do not apply.
