JUDGMENT

The claimant's application dated **6 July 2019** for reconsideration of the orders sent to the parties on **27 June 2019** is refused save with respect to the application for reconsideration of the amount of deposit orders (dealt with by separate letter to the parties).

REASONS

There is no reasonable prospect of the original decision being varied or revoked, because:

- (1) The claimant's claims were addressed in the hearing and the issues for consideration are set out at paragraph 9 of the preliminary hearing summary.
- (2) I was required to make a summary assessment of the merits of the breach of contract claim when deciding whether to make a deposit order, which I did.
- (3) The claimant's argument in respect of discrimination on grounds of sexual orientation is difficult to understand: he had withdrawn his complaint of sex discrimination and there was no hint of a complaint of discrimination because of sexual orientation in his grounds of claim. In those circumstances he needed permission to amend to include it and I refused permission for the reasons given at the time. There is no prospect of this decision being varied or revoked.
