Freedom of Information Act A12 bypasses

Thank you for your email of 23 July requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 asking for details of when the villages of Farnham, Little Glemham, Stratford St Andrew, Marlesford and Wrentham located along the A12 between Ipswich and Lowestoft, were last considered for possible bypassing.

A New Deal for Trunk Roads in England published in July 1998 by the then Department for Environment, Transport and the Regions, set out a proposal to detrunk the A12 between Ipswich and Lowestoft.

Detrunking was completed in June 2001 and responsibility for the maintenance, repair and upgrading of the A12 between Ipswich and Lowestoft passed to Suffolk County Council as the new highway authority.

It is possible that Suffolk County Council has considered proposals to bypass those villages since 2001. If you would like to contact them to make a Freedom of Information request, you may do so by emailing information.management@suffolk.gov.uk.
