JUDGMENT

On the Respondent not entering a response the judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The Respondent breached the Claimant's contract of employment and shall pay to the Claimant £6,285.06 (9 weeks notice pay at £698.34 per week.
- 2. The Respondent shall pay to the Claimant £5,446.98 for unpaid holiday (33 days at £165.06 per day).
- 3. The Respondent made unauthorised deductions from the Claimant's wages and shall pay to the Claimant £30,726.96.
- 4. The Respondent unfairly dismissed the Claimant and shall pay a compensatory award to the Claimant of £49,429.32 (loss of earning to date of hearing £30,726.96, future loss of earnings £18,352.36, pension contributions £586.56 and loss of statutory rights £350.00).
