JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that :-

- 1.In relation to the Claimant's claim that he was unfairly dismissed ,this claim is not well founded. This claim is hereby dismissed.
- 2. In relation to the Claimant's claim for notice pay, this claim is not well founded. This claim is hereby dismissed.
- 3. In relation to the Claimant's claim for redundancy pay, this claim is not well founded. This claim is hereby dismissed
- 4. In relation to the Claimant 's claim for unpaid sums in relation to mileage costs in the sum of £369. 50, this claim is well founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay this sum to the Claimant.
- 5. In relation to the Claimant's claim that he has been underpaid in the sum of £2,317.99, this claim is partially well founded in that for the days worked between 13th July and 5th August 2018, the Claimant should have been paid at the rate of £140 per day gross. In respect of this

claim, the parties agreed that the sum of $\underline{\$560.00}$ shall be payable by the Respondent to the Claimant.
