

# **NOTICE OF ORDER TOWN & COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 SECTION 257**

Doncaster Metropolitan Borough Council  
Public Path Diversion Order 2019  
Public Footpath No 2 (Part) Austerfield

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is **23 July 2019**.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to divert the public footpath commencing at Grid Reference SK 6657 9624 (Point A on the map attached to the Order) at its junction with public bridleway Austerfield number 3 proceeding in a northerly direction for 468 metres to Grid Reference SK 6665 9669 (Point B on the map attached to the Order), and create an alternative footpath instead to a line commencing at Grid Reference SK 6665 9669 (Point B on the map attached to the Order) proceeding in a westerly direction for 63 metres, then south-west for 605 metres to its junction with bridleway Austerfield number 3 at Grid Reference SK 6617 9632 (Point C on the map attached to the Order) as shown on the Order Map. The path will have a width of 3 metres.

## **Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments**

### **Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 6 August 2019]**

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

**Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 17 September 2019]**

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

**Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 29 October 2019]**

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties everyone should keep to the timetable to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.

PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO 2 (PART) AUSTERFIELD**

This Order is made by Doncaster Borough Council ("the Council") under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (TCPA 1990) because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the footpath to which this order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of TPCA namely authorising the development of Bawtry Golf Club, planning application number 17/00910/FULM.

**BY THIS ORDER:**

1. The footpath over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") shall be diverted as provided below.
2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of the Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and showed by bold black dashes on the attached map.
3. The diversion of the footpath shall have effect on the date on which the Council certify that the terms of Article 2 above have been complied with
