JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d)

REASONS

- The claimant was formerly represented by a solicitor. The solicitor withdrew from acting on 27 December 2018. The claimant did not appear and was not represented at the hearing on 4 March 2019.
- On 4 March 2019, the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 14 March 2019 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.
- The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
