Thank you for your email of 5 March 2019 requesting the following information:

"An article in today's edition of the Colchester Gazette* contains the following quote attributed to an MOD spokesperson, with regard to the MOD's disposal of Middlewick Ranges, Colchester:

"Over the past two years we have undertaken extensive engagement with stakeholders, including local authorities, carried out detailed studies and completed further financial modelling to understand the best way to deliver our intended strategy."

Please provide a breakdown of these engagements, studies and models, and the results/conclusions where possible."

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and I can confirm that some information in scope of your request is held.

The information you have requested can be found below and enclosed at Annexes A-F. However, some of the information falls entirely within the scope of the absolute exemption provided for at section 40 (Personal Data) of the FOIA and the qualified exemptions provided for at section 43 (Commercial) of the FOIA. This information has been redacted or withheld.

Section 40(2) has been applied to some of the information in order to protect personal information as governed by the General Data Protection Regulation and Data Protection Act 2018. Section 40 is an absolute exemption and therefore there is no requirement to consider the public interest in making a decision to withhold the information.

Section 43(2) has been applied to some of the information requested because if released it would be likely to prejudice the commercial interests of any person (including the public authority holding it). This exemption is subject to a Public Interest Test (PIT) which means that the information requested can only be withheld if the public interest in doing so outweighs the public interest in disclosure. A PIT has been conducted and I am satisfied in this case that the balance of the public interest lies in withholding the information because if disclosed, it could prejudice the future use of the site.

With regards to MODs engagement with stakeholders, some of this information is exempt under Section 21 of the FOIA because it is reasonably accessible to you. I am pleased to inform you that you can access it via the following links:

Further information relating to MODs engagement with stakeholders can be found enclosed at Annexes A-F.

With reference to studies and models carried out over the past two years and the subsequent results/conclusions, I can confirm the MOD holds no information in scope of this request.

Under Section 16 of the Act (Advice and Assistance) you may find it helpful to note that the statement: "Over the past two years we have undertaken extensive engagement with stakeholders, including local authorities, carried out detailed studies and completed further financial modelling to understand the best way to deliver our intended strategy" relates to the Better Defence Estate Strategy as a whole and is not limited to Middlewick Ranges. Studies directly relating to the disposal of Middlewick Ranges were conducted however, these studies were undertaken over two years ago and are therefore outside the timeframe of your request.




