JUDGMENT

1. The allegations and/or claims set out in paragraph 2.1 of the Order of 17 June 2019 are struck out.
2. The balance of the claim proceeds in accordance with the case management directions of even date.

REASONS

1. At the Preliminary Hearing which took place on 17 June 2019, the Judge considered that some of the Claimant's allegations had little reasonable prospect of success;
 - (i) The allegation that the letter of 31 May 2018 was a public interest disclosure;
 - (ii) The allegations of direct discrimination set out within paragraphs 5 (2)-(4) of the List of Issues which was attached to the Summary and Order;
 - (iii) The complaint of automatic unfair dismissal under s. 103A of the Employment Rights Act.
2. The Claimant failed to pay some or all of the deposit sums in accordance with paragraph 2 of the Order. She did attempt to provide further evidence of her means which the Judge rejected on 19 July 2019 as having been inconsistent with the account given to him at the hearing on 17 June.
