JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the Tribunal is that:

1. The claim for breach of contract is well founded; alternatively
2. The claim in respect of unlawful deduction from wages is well founded.

3. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the sum of £735 which sum, for the avoidance of doubt, is in satisfaction of both claims and is ordered gross.
