We refer to your email dated 26 April 2019 to the Ministry of Defence Police which was acknowledged on the 29 April 2019.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following information:

"Can you please tell me for each of the years 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018

How many incidents of drink-spiking were recorded by your force?

Please search for this data by means of keyword searches of MO codes, using the terms 'spike', 'spiking', 'drink-spike', 'drink spiked', spiked drink', while checking to make sure that they don't refer to some other context (e.g. 'a spiked fence' or 'spiked hair').

Finally, can you please attach the first five MO codes from January 2018 for drink spiking-related offences? I accept redactions may need to be made to remove personal information."

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.
