JUDGMENT

The claim against the first Respondent is struck out.

REASONS

1. By a letter dated 29 January 2019 the Tribunal gave the Claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the claim against the first Respondent only should not be struck out because
 - the claimant had not complied with Order 5 of the Tribunal dated 31 October 2018 and that thus it was also not being actively pursued.
2. The claimant has failed to make any representations in writing as ordered, the claim against the first Respondent only is therefore struck out.
3. The remedy hearing against the second Respondent remains listed for hearing on the 12 April 2019 with a reduced time estimate of three hours commencing at 10am or as soon thereafter on that day as the Tribunal can hear it.
