Thank you for your request for information about vehicle movement on the A249 between junction 7 of the M20 and Queenborough, dated 1 August. I have dealt with your request under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Please find attached the estimated average annual daily flow, by direction, data from 2000 to 2018 for the A249 between the M20 at junction 7 and Queenborough (B2007/A250).
