JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the tribunal is as follows:

Liability

1. The claim of direct sex discrimination (relating to dismissal) is well founded.

Remedy

- 2. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £15,000.00 for injury to feelings.
- 3. Interest is payable on the above sum (based on the date of discrimination being 17 November 2017) of £2,112.18.
- 4. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £7,960.53 in respect of loss of earnings to date. This sum does not fall to be adjusted.
