IV. HEALTH INFORMATION

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian certify that:

- 1) The birds are captive bred and did not originate from the wild.
- 2) The birds were resident in a government approved facility/premise in the United Kingdom for at least two (2) years prior to importation OR* since they were hatched.
- 3) The United Kingdom is officially free from **Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI)** for past six (06) months prior to export OR* the facility/premises of origin were situated in an area in which no case of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) has occurred within a 25 km radius, in the 6 months prior to export.
- 4) The birds were kept in isolation in an approved facility since they were hatched or for the 21 days prior to shipment and showed no clinical signs of infectious diseases, including avian influenza, during the isolation period.
- 5) During the above isolation period, all birds, or a sample of birds from one consignment were subject to at least one of the following diagnostic tests for H5 and H7 avian influenza and the test result is negative:
 - a) **** Virus isolation test:** The sample size should not be fewer than 30 birds. (Pooling is permitted with not more than 10 samples in each pool); OR*
 - b) **** Serology test,** using Agar Gel Immunodiffusion Test or Haemagglutination Inhibition Test. (The sample size should not be fewer than 20 birds); OR*
 - c) **** RT-PCR test:** The sample size should not be fewer than 30 birds and the birds must be individually tested;
 - d) The tests must be carried out within 14 days prior to export and done by an official diagnostic laboratory approved by the Competent Authority of the United Kingdom. Testing methods shall follow the protocols as set out in the "OIE Manual of Standards for Diagnostic Tests and Vaccines".
- 6) For **Psittaciformes** only:

- a) Showed no clinical signs of avian Chlamydiosis, Pacheco's Disease and Psittacine Proventricular Dilatation Syndrome (PPDS) on the day of examination.
- b) Were kept under veterinary supervision for 45 days prior to shipment and were treated against chlamydiosis using doxycycline or chlortetracycline.
- 7) The birds were examined within 48 hours prior to export and found to be free from any clinical signs of infectious or contagious diseases, external parasites, and are healthy and fit to travel.
- 8) The birds are transported in new or appropriately sanitized containers.

9) **TRANSHIPMENT**

I have received a written declaration from the exporter that in the case of transshipment or transit via other countries, the animal will not leave the cargo transshipment area of the airport or will be in isolation in an approved quarantine during transshipment.

10) **TRANSPORTATION TO BRUNEI**

- a) The vehicles in which the animals will be transported from the pre-export isolation facility / premises to the port of departure were cleaned and disinfected prior to loading using a disinfectant approved by Defra;
- b) During transport to the port of departure the animals will be kept isolated from animals that were not of equivalent health status.
- c) As far as it can be determined, no other animals are being transported in the aircraft or ship except animals officially certified by an Official Veterinarian for export from United Kingdom to Brunei Darussalam.
- d) If shipped by air, the animals will be shipped in accordance with the International Air Transport Association (IATA) Live Animal Regulations.

**Note: If the birds have been vaccinated against avian influenza, the nature of the vaccine used and the date of vaccination should be attached to the certificate.*

This certificate is valid for 10 consecutive days from the date of certification.
