CORRECTED JUDGMENT on RECONSIDERATION

1. The Judgment omitted reference to the dismissal of the disability discrimination claim.
2. The Judgment as earlier reconsidered and as now corrected under Rule 69 of the Employment Tribunal (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013, Schedule 1, is as follows.

The claimant was unfairly dismissed and the First Respondent is ordered to pay the sum of £12,867.20 to her in respect of the unfair dismissal, including the sum increased under section 38 of the Employment Act 2002 in respect of the failure to provide a statement of employment particulars.

The First Respondent is ordered to pay damages of £1129 to the claimant in respect of breach of contract.

The First Respondent is ordered to pay the claimant £247.83 in respect of unlawful deduction from wages.

The total sums payable to the claimant by the First Respondent are £14,244.03.

The claim in respect of disability discrimination against the First Respondent is dismissed.

The claims against the second and third respondents are dismissed.
