

Declaration of Exempt Works

Description of works

The installation of a row, not exceeding 200 metres in length, of obstacles (wooden posts) which are intended to prevent vehicular access to common land, where the owner reasonably considers that such access would interfere with or be detrimental to the use of the land by members of the public for the purpose of open-air recreation pursuant to the rights of access defined by Section 193 of the Law of Property Act 1925 and by the Countryside and Rights of Way Act 2000.




