JUDGMENT

The judgment of the tribunal is that:

- 1. The complaint of unauthorised deductions from wages is struck out on the ground that it has no reasonable prospect of success.
- 2. The complaint of age discrimination is struck out on the ground that it has no reasonable prospect of success.
- The complaint of sex discrimination struck out on the ground that it was presented out of time and it would not be just and equitable to extend time to permit the tribunal to consider it.
