JUDGMENT

- 1. The tribunal refuses the claimant's application to amend his claim so as to introduce an allegation that he was constructively dismissed.
- 2. The tribunal has no jurisdiction to consider the complaint of unfair dismissal or the claim for damages for breach of contract. These complaints were not presented until after the expiry of the statutory time limit and it was reasonably practicable for them to have been presented before the time limit expired.
- 3. In any event:
 - 3.1. The claimant was not unfairly dismissed; and
 - 3.2. The respondent was contractually entitled to dismiss him without giving notice.
- 4. The claim is therefore dismissed.
