## **JUDGMENT**

1. The claimant's claim is dismissed.

## **REASONS**

- 1. The claimant presented a claim for unauthorised deduction of wages and/or breach of contract.
- 2. The claimant worked for the respondent for six days between 16 and 23 July 2018. At the time of her claim she had not been paid.
- 3. The claimant told me she was paid a salary of £21,000 for a six day week, 9am 6pm. That equates to £403.85 gross per week.
- 4. The claimant worked nine hours overtime on the six days after 6pm. She could not tell me the overtime rate. At the national minimum wage of £7.38 that would represent £66.72.
- 5. On 3 May 2019 the respondent paid the claimant £477.27.
- 6. £403.85 plus £66.42 = £470.27
