<u>Your request for information dated 2 August, 2019- Freedom of Information Act 2000</u>

Thank you for your email of 2 August to Anne Ball requesting the following information regarding our Catering Services, Security Services, Cleaning Services, Hard and Soft Maintenance Services, Mechanical and Electrical Services.

The details you require are:

- Suppliers who applied for inclusion and were successful & not successful at the PQQ & ITT stages*
- Copy of the successful suppliers ITT submission
- Contract values of each contract year to date
- Start date & duration of contract
- Scope of services provided under current contract
- Is there an extension clause in the contract(s) and, if so, the duration of the extension?
- Has a decision been made yet on whether the contract(s) are being either extended or renewed?
- Who is the senior officer (outside of procurement) responsible for this contract?

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'), you have the right to:

- know whether we hold the information you require;
- be provided with that information (subject to any exemptions under the Act which may apply).

The answers to your questions are that the Office of Manpower Economics (OME) does not hold the information you require. The OME is funded by the <u>Department for Business</u>, <u>Energy and Industrial Strategy</u> (BEIS), and they would be responsible for all Procurement and IT services provided to the Office.

Consequently, you may wish to contact BEIS FOI for the information you are seeking.
