JUDGMENT

1. The respondent has failed to file an ET3 Grounds of Resistance in this case.
2. Having considered the ET1, EJ Joffe has decided that a determination of the claim can properly be made without a hearing and **the hearing listed for 15 October will not take place.**
3. The Judgment of the Tribunal, made under rule 21 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013, is that the respondent unlawfully failed to pay wages to the claimant and was in breach of the claimant's contract in failing to pay notice pay.

Compensation

4. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant:
 - 4.1 Wages of £1606.72 net (the sum due less £2000 paid by the respondent)
 - 4.2 £2219.52 net damages for failure to pay notice pay and
 - 4.4 £693.60 net accrued holiday pay under regulation 14 Working Time Regulations 1999.
5. The respondent is ordered to account to HMRC for the tax due on the above sums.
6. The hearing on 15 October 2019 is vacated and the parties should not attend.
