Thank you for your email of 5 July 2019 requesting the following information:

"I am writing to request a copy of the most recent version of JSP 315 Part 2 Building Performance Standards - BPS 1.2 - Service Families Accommodation"

Following approval by Defence Infrastructure Organisation IAC, the JSP 315 building performance standards have been endorsed as MOD policy.


The standards themselves are held on the <u>Knowledge in Defence (KiD)</u> hosted through the Defence Gateway.










