## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. The Claimant's claim of automatic unfair dismissal contrary to section 104 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 is dismissed on withdrawal.
- 2. The Respondent has made an unauthorised deduction from the Claimant's wages and is ordered to pay her the gross sum of £36.39.
- 3. The Tribunal makes no separate award in respect of holiday pay under the Working Time Regulations 1998.
- 4. The Claimant was engaged by the Respondent under a contract of apprenticeship.
- 5. The apprenticeship was not an Authorised English Apprenticeship within the definition in the Apprenticeships, Skills, Children & Learning Act 2009 (as amended).
- 6. In breach of contract the Respondent terminated the Claimant's contract before completion of her apprenticeship and shall pay her damages for breach of contract in the sum of £4,477.
- 7. The recoupment provisions do not apply.
