- 1. The Claimant is entitled to a redundancy payment and the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the gross sum of £2,018.75.
- 2. The Respondent has failed to pay the Claimant notice pay and is ordered to pay the Claimant the gross sum of £2,018.75.
- 3. The Respondent has failed to pay the Claimant's outstanding holiday entitlement and is ordered to pay the Claimant the gross sum of £242.52.
- 4. The Respondent has failed to pay the Claimant his entitlement to five weeks' wages and is ordered to pay the gross sum of £2,018.75.
