JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant's claim for a statutory redundancy payment and unlawful deductions from wages succeeds.
- 2. The Tribunal orders that the Respondent pay the Claimant the sum of £7,843.00 (gross) made up as follows:
 - a. A statutory redundancy payment of £3,675.00
 - b. Holiday pay of £1,373.00
 - c. Notice pay of £2,795.00
- 3. The Claimant is responsible for payment of tax and national insurance due on this sum, if any.
