

## NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MODIFY PUBLIC PATH ORDER

### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

Notice is hereby given pursuant to paragraph 2(3) of Schedule 6 to the Highways Act 1980 that the Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs to determine the Dorset County Council (Footpaths 37 (part), 38 and 103 (part), Thorncombe) Public Path Diversion Order 2015 proposes to modify the order by providing for the following modifications:

- In the Schedule to the Order (Parts 1-4) and on the Order plan delete references to 'E', 'J', and 'L' and delete the associated grid references where they occur
- In the Schedule to the Order (Parts 1-4) and on the Order plan insert new points and where appropriate new grid references as follows,  
E1 (ST 37510325)  
J1 (ST 3752503296)  
L1 (ST 37350319)
- In Part 3 of the Schedule to the Order, Limitations and Conditions, for Footpath 103, Thorncombe, Furniture, delete 'Medium mobility kissing gate' and insert 'Gap'
- On the Order plan, delete the broken line between E and J and insert a broken line between E1 and J1

A copy of the order as submitted and a copy of the order showing the proposed modification together with the Inspector's Order decision dated 21 October 2019 have been deposited at the offices of Dorset Council, Main Reception, County Hall, Colliton Park, Dorchester, Dorset, DT1 1XJ and may be inspected free of charge during normal working hours.
