CONSENT JUDGMENT

1. Having heard from the claimant in person and from Mr Charity, on behalf of the respondent, by consent it is ordered as follows: –

- (i) the respondent shall pay the claimant the sum of £3,000, of which £1,000 is notice pay and £1760 is compensation for the loss of his employment;
- (ii) payment of the above sum, less income tax and national insurance deductions, shall be paid to the claimant by not later than 4pm Friday 8 November 2019;
- (iii) the said payment to the claimant is in full and final settlement of all claims arising out of his employment with respondent under the above case number; and
- (iv) the claims are withdrawn and shall be dismissed on 9 November 2019 by the tribunal unless informed otherwise by the claimant prior to that date.
