The Tribunal entered judgment in default on 7 October 2019. The Tribunal heard evidence from the claimant and considered the documents the claimant produced, and the Tribunal's file. The respondent did not attend.

The Tribunal's judgment is that

- 1. The respondent must pay to the claimant the sum of £10,000 and interest of £593.97 for injury of the claimant's feelings arising from discrimination because of the claimant's disability and his sex;
- The respondent must pay to the claimant the further sum of £9,596 and interest of £283.94 for losses consequential to the respondent's acts of discrimination against the claimant;

Therefore the total that the respondent owes to the claimant is £20,473.91;
The above awards are made under the Equality Act 2010.
